PART A

EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MALAYSIAN FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS 134: INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING ("MFRS 134")

A1. Basis of Preparation

The unaudited condensed interim financial statements for the third quarter ended 30 September 2013 have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 *Interim Financial Reporting* and with IAS 34 *Interim Financial Reporting*, and the applicable disclosure provisions on paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities"), and should be read in conjunction with the annual audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2012

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements are prepared under historical cost convention, which are in compliance with MFRSs and the requirements of the Companies Act 1965 in Malaysia. These are the Group's first set of condensed interim financial statements prepared in accordance with MFRSs, which are also in line with International Financial Reporting Standards as issued by the International Accounting Standards Board.

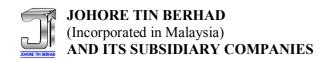
A2. Changes in Accounting Policies

There were no issuance, cancellation, repurchases, resale and repayment of debts and equity securities for the current financial reporting period.

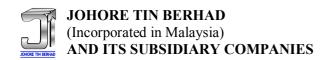

PART B

EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF THE BURSA SECURITIES

B1. Review of Group Performance

a) Current Year Quarter compared with Preceding Year Corresponding Quarter

The Group has recorded a revenue of RM63.473 million and profit before tax of RM8.167 million for the third quarter itself as compared to preceding year corresponding quarter of RM64.746 million and RM9.607 million respectively. A decrease in revenue of RM1.273 million as compared to the 3rd quarter of the preceding year due to demand decreases in various industries. As a result, profit before tax decreased by RM1.44 million.

For the tin manufacturing industry, the revenue increased by RM2.356 million to RM20.195 million due to demand increase in edible oil industry. However, profit before tax was decreased by RM1.45 million to RM3.125 million due to increases in operating costs and reversal of provision for doubtful debts in previous year's quarter.

As for the Food and Beverage ("F&B") industry, the revenue decreased by RM3.63 million to RM43.277 million. The profit before tax, however, decreased marginally by RM0.372 million to RM5.316 million. Overall, the demand & cost of production are well-maintained as compared to preceding year corresponding quarter.

b) Current Year-To-Date compared with Preceding Year-To-Date

The Group has recorded a revenue of RM176.807 million and profit before tax of RM22.22 million for the 9 months period ended 30 September 2013 as compared to preceding year-to-date of RM180.434 million and RM20.279 million respectively. Despite a minor reduction in revenue of RM3.627 million as compared to the period of the preceding year, profit before tax increased by RM1.941 million, as the Group managed to take advantage of the higher efficiency in its operations during this quarter.

For the tin manufacturing industry, the revenue increased by RM3.885 million to RM63.435 million due to higher demand in biscuit and edible oil industries, while the profit before tax increased by RM1.885 to RM11.07 million due to the increased revenue.

As for the F&B industry, the revenue decreased by RM7.512 million to RM113.372 million mainly due to lower demand in the dairy market. Profit before tax increased marginally by RM0.073 million to RM12.05 million due to higher efficiency in its operations.

B2. Variation of Results against Preceding Quarter

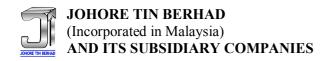
For the current quarter under review, the Group's profit before tax increased by RM0.403 million to RM8.167 million as compared to RM7.764 million in the preceding quarter ended 30 June 2013.

a) Tin Manufacturing Industry

The slight decrease in profit before tax of RM0.95 million to RM3.125 million due to gain on disposal of assets in previous year.

b) F&B Industry

The increase in profit before tax of RM1.245 million to RM5.316 million was mainly due to demand increases for the current quarter under review as compared to preceding quarter.



B3. Prospects of the Group

a) Tin Manufacturing Industry

Raw materials prices are expected to increase marginally in the near-term. However, demand is expected to maintain and remain stable.

The Group will continue to maintain its profitability for the year of 2013 despite a challenging global economic situation.

b) F&B Industry

Although the milk powder prices have slight fluctuation, we do not foresee any significant changes of the prices in the near future.

The demand for the year 2013 is expected to be strong and this segment will continue to be profitable.

B4. Revenue or Profit Estimates

This is not applicable to the Group for the current financial reporting period under review.

B5. Profit Forecast or Profit Guarantee

The profit forecast is not applicable to the Group.

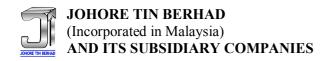
As for the profit guarantee, subject to the clauses in the Share Sale Agreement, the newly acquired subsidiary has achieved the profit after tax (the "profit guarantee") of not less than RM7 million for the financial year ended 31 December 2011 and RM10 million for the financial year ended 31 December 2012, of which the Vendor has been paid RM5 million (2011: RM3.5 million) for the current financial reporting period under review.

B6. Status of Corporate Proposals and Utilisation of Proceeds Raised from Rights Issue

The Company has increased its share capital by 23,326,333 new ordinary shares of RM1.00 each at an issue price of RM1.28 each per share, amounting to RM29,857,706.24 from the Rights Issue.

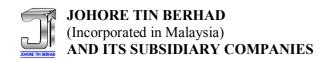

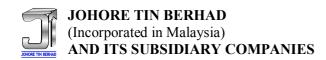

All contracts entered by the Group are executed with creditworthy financial institutions in Malaysia. As a result, the credit risk or the risk of counterparties defaulting is minimal. The Group also has a low liquidity risk as it maintains sufficient fund to settle the entire derivative financial instruments when they fall due.

However, the Group is subject to market risk in term of foreign currency, on sales and purchases that are denominated in foreign currency other than Ringgit Malaysia. The Group maintains a nature hedge, whenever is possible, by matching the receivables and the payables in the same currency, any unmatched balances will be hedged by the forward foreign currency contracts.

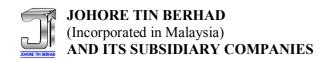

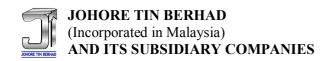

B17. Proposed Dividend

During the financial reporting period under review, the Board of Directors has declared a single-tier First Interim Dividend of 3%, amounting to RM2,799,160, in respect of the financial year ending 31 December 2013.

The payment date and entitlement date of the First Interim Dividend will be determined at a later date.

B18. Material Litigations

We refer to the announcement made under item 14.5 of Material Litigations stipulated in the Prospectus dated 19 September 2003.

The suit was brought by General Containers Sdn Bhd ("GCSB") against the former director of GCSB, Mr. Tan Chin Wah for breach of fiduciary duties and against the subsidiaries of the Company, Johore Tin Factory Sendirian Berhad and Unican Industries Sdn Bhd ("Defendants") for conspiring to divest GCSB of its vital assets and business. A judgment was ruled in favour of the Defendants by the Johor Bahru High Court ("High Court") on 29 October 2010 when the High Court dismissed the suit with costs.

GCSB has appealed against this decision to the Court of Appeal and was dismissed with costs on 8 November 2012. Subsequently, GCSB has applied for leave to appeal to the Federal Court on 9 September 2013, by a panel of five (5) Federal Court Judges, and the application was dismissed with costs to the Defendants ("the wholly-owned subsidiaries of the Company").

As a result, GCSB will not be able to appeal any further on this matter.

Other than the above, there were no pending material litigations since the date of last audited annual statement of financial position.

B19. Authorisation for Issue

The interim financial statements were authorised for issued by the Board of Directors in accordance to the Board of Directors meeting held on 20 November 2013.
